- *Planning and monitoring construction to minimize impacts*
We identify the best construction methods and solutions to ensure a project meets the community's needs, and impacts are reduced while it's being built. We evaluate each possible approach to arrive at the design and sequence that most capably delivers the project safely, on time, on budget, and to the required specifications. When applicable, we consider if alternative methods, like accelerated bridge construction (ABC), could reduce the duration and severity of closures. Kiewit crews take proactive measures to carefully monitor noise, vibrations, dust and other environmental impacts, especially when working in sensitive environments, like hospitals or schools.
- *Partnering with our clients to inform the public*
We support our clients' public information efforts to inform communities of the our work. Our teams are aligned with our clients to assure everyone is on the same page regarding our operations. We might provide information and join our clients at stakeholder meetings, or build out an entire public information program, complete with business outreach, social media and even mobile app components, to keep the public engaged and informed.
