The projects we build are found in urban, suburban and rural areas across the U.S., Canada and Mexico. Each new location has its own unique surroundings, from open fields to dense neighborhoods. We take our role as environmental stewards seriously, and work to understand our surroundings on each new site. With the proper permitting and permissions, we're diligent in our efforts to build responsibly and monitor the impacts of our work.

Our environmental department, environmental managers across North America, and on-site environmental coordinators lead these efforts and work to train all employees to ensure they understand rules, regulations and expectations they're held to.

OUR EFFORTS

Our commitment to be good stewards of the environment includes:

- ***Managing environmental compliance***
Achieving environmental compliance is a continuous obligation of our company and our employees. Our environmental department oversees these efforts and adapts our environmental programs to comply with changing laws and regulations in places where we work. We track all environmental incidents, evaluate these trends, and use these lessons to improve our training and ultimately our overall performance.
- ***Assigning accountability on our projects***
Every Kiewit project delegates a team member responsible for environmental management on the job site. These individuals are responsible for training staff and craft employees on environmental management and oversee the project's environmental compliance. Our environmental department and environmental managers in offices across the U.S., Canada and Mexico provide ongoing training and guidance for these individuals to ensure they're prepared to carry out these responsibilities.
- ***Delivering environmental training***
Kiewit employees are responsible for compliance with environmental laws and regulations. Employees are trained in applicable practices in stormwater management, spill prevention and control, waste management, air quality and process water management, to ensure our projects are built responsibly. Training materials and information are available to all employees, which includes procedures and manuals to help our folks understand their roles and responsibilities.
- ***Operating sustainably***
A key component to operate sustainably is our corporate idling policy. By implementing the idling policy, which does not allow Kiewit's vehicles and equipment to idle longer than five minutes, we're reducing fuel consumption, diesel emissions, and noise, as well as decreasing vehicle and equipment maintenance. Our environmental department works to identify other sustainable practices like reducing waste and water consumption at our offices and projects to minimize our collective impact on the environment.
